Re-Evaluation Guidelines

1. A student may apply for re-evaluation of his/her Semester End Examination (SEE) answer script within five (5) working days from the date of declaration of results, on payment of the prescribed fee.
2. The re-evaluation fee is ₹500/- per paper.
3. The duly filled application form shall be submitted to the University Examination Centre within the stipulated time. Late applications shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
4. A student may first apply for scrutiny of the evaluated answer script for verification of totalling and clerical errors. Scrutiny is limited to verification of totalling and correct entry of marks only and does not involve re-evaluation of answers.
5. The evaluated answer booklet shall be made available to the student for perusal, and the student shall verify the same only within the University Examination Department. The student shall not be permitted to take the answer booklet outside the Examination Department, nor shall any copy, photograph, or reproduction of the answer script be allowed.
6. If the student is not satisfied with the outcome of the scrutiny, he/she may subsequently apply for re-evaluation of the answer script within the prescribed time limit.
7. Re-evaluation is permitted only for University Theory Examinations and is restricted to a maximum of two (2) subjects only.
8. Re-evaluation is not applicable for the following:
 - Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) / Mid-Term Examinations
 - Laboratory-based courses
 - Seminars
 - Project work
 - Internships
9. The answer script shall be evaluated afresh by two new examiners, and the re-evaluation results shall be published within fifteen (15) working days from the last date of application.
10. The original marks awarded shall be governed by the following conditions:
 - a) If the average marks awarded by the two re-evaluators vary up to 15% of the original marks awarded, the original marks shall remain unchanged.
 - b) If the average marks awarded by the two re-evaluators vary by more than 15% of the original marks, the average of the original marks and the re-evaluation marks shall be treated as final.
 - c) The result shall be changed only if there is a change in the result status (Pass/Fail) in the concerned course/subject. Otherwise, the original result shall remain unchanged.
11. Students shall abide by the result of the re-evaluation, even if it is adverse.
12. The merit list declared for the respective examination shall not be affected or revised on account of re-evaluation of answer scripts.
13. In the event of any change/no-change in the examination result due to re-evaluation, no student shall have the right to challenge the same in any court of law, nor shall any action lie against the Examiner(s), the Institute, or the University.
